Author Visit Checklist

Materials Needed: For large assemblies in gymnasiums or auditoriums I'll need a projector and a microphone. For workshops, each student should come with a pencil or pen, a few sheets of notebook paper, and something to write on (preferably a desk or table).

Author Visit Packet: Once we've agreed on a date and time I'll send a packet including a photo, bios of various lengths to use as you see fit, teacher resources meant to complement my books and visit, and an invoice for your records.

Read My Books: If possible, please read my book(s) to the students, or suggest they do so, **before my visit**. Resource materials available in the Author Visit Packet may be of interest to teachers and will enhance the author visit for students. For example, teachers may want to do a performance of *If Chocolate Were Purple* with their students (guide provided in the Author Visit Packet), or dovetail the visit with a unit on memoirs and/or biographies (guide also provided in packet).

Selling Books: I am always happy to spend time after visits selling and signing books, if that works for your school. It's usually great one-on-one time with kids, too! If you're interested, let me know and we'll coordinate as we plan the visit.

Fee: The agreed upon fee for my visit is due the day of the visit.
